“I had no tools to help them tackle this issue,” said the Modesto resident. “So I wanted to give people an opportunity to keep

their pet as healthy as they like to keep themselves.”

She offers in-home health consultations, workouts, walks, pool therapy and more. She has also sponsored public dog walks at Davis Park benefiting animal charities. She said her services are customized and fees are negotiable. Daily walks usually range from \$10 to \$12.
